On a Windows machine you can also use the Magnifier. Press the **Windows** logo key + Plus sign (+) on the keyboard to turn **Magnifier** on. Press **Windows** logo key + Esc to turn it off. To turn **Magnifier** on and off using touch or a mouse, select Start > Settings > Ease of Access > **Magnifier** , and switch on the toggle under Turn on **Magnifier**. Also **Ctrl**+ zooms in; **Ctrl**- zooms out and **Ctrl**0 (zero) returns to the original size. Hold down the Ctrl button and press +, – or 0 (zero).
